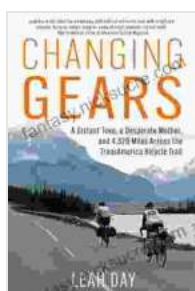


A Distant Teenager's Desperate Mother and the Cross-Country Bicycle Journey That Reunited Them

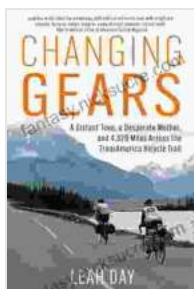
